

Kolkacape – meeting place created by Nature

The Livonian Coast is a narrow coastal strip in North Kurzeme from Gipka to Ovisi. Here you will find 12 villages with a small number of Livonians descendants who still treasure their cultural monuments.

The Livonians are one of the seven Baltic Sea Finnish nations, Estonians and Finns being their closest kin in this family.

The Livonians are an ancient indigenous nation in Latvia, the language and culture of which from a significant part of the whole Latvian culture heritage. The Livonian language has existed for over 1500 years. A small number of users have kept it alive. It has a generally recognised linguistic value and as such has been filed in several registers, including the UNESCO register of endangered languages.

From 2002 – 2004 studied professional photography in Ghent Academy of Visual Art (Belglum).


From 1998 – 2007 photographed the Livonian Coast. Received Latvian Award of Photography of

Received 3 Latvian Music Records Awards. Established his music record company "Moonlight Sound Design" in 2007.
























