

Arenduskoda

- NGO Arenduskoda has now 61 members: 5 members of the locale municipalities, 33 NGOs and 23 members of the business sector.
- NGO Arenduskoda's Board has 6 members.
- The activity zone of Arenduskoda is 1695,16 km², which includes 180 inhabited points, one town as an independent member (Loksa) and one town within the municipality (Tapa).
- 23 420 people are living in the Arenduskoda area .

History

- NGO Arenduskoda's history goes back to year 1994. That year in November with cooperation of National Labour Market Institution and Tapa town the ME Rehabilitation Center was established. The Center made it possible for the residents to improve their language skills, study computers and take part of various kinds of lectures. We also have a licensed training center.
- 12th June 2006, NGO Arenduskoda was reorganized to an action group which is conformed to the requirements set by the LEADER programme.

Leader period 2007-2013

- 581 local life development applications have been submitted
- 371 applications (in sum 3 263 871 EUR) have been approved by the board of Development Centre and sent to the national Agricultural Registers and Information Office for financing request.
- One transnational Leader cooperation project “Loving local values” was implemented during last period together with Finnish LAG Sepra from South-East of Finland as a leading partner.

Leader period 2014-2020

- 4 priorities (among these 3 thematic):
 - Entrepreneurship
 - Community life
 - Cultural heritage
- The 4th priority – networking – is horizontal
- The overall aim resulting from the above priorities is the development of services for local food production, preserving and valuing resources available in the area.
