



Green Riverland Partnership The Green Riverland situated of South-West Estonia. Area:2998 km2, population: 27 257 The region is delimited by natural borders - swamps, big forests and rivers. Traffic going around of big swamp, which lies in centrum of this area. In centre of this area is Soomaa National Park.

- GRP's name derives from the location of the region in the middle of swamps, rivers and bogs and is described as follows:
- Green forests, swamps, flora and fauna and Soomaa National Park;
- Riverland Pärnu basin and lakes, waterway and fifth season in Soomaa;



Soomaa National Park

- The Soomaa National Park is located between the Sakala Uplands, the coastal shallows of the Gulf of Livonia, and the West Estonian lowlands in the south-west of Estonia.
- The national park was established on 8 December 1993.
- Surface area is 396 km2
- The area of the national park includes the territories of 19 villages with a total of 58 households.
- 54 permanent year-round residents live in
 21 households of six of the villages
- is managed by the Environmental Board of the Repubic of Estonia
- The Estonian name of Soomaa National Park (Land of Bogs) refers to the fact that bogs with paludified meadows and swamp forests make up 80 per cent of its territory.

"Fifth season"

- The high-water season in Soomaa is also called the "fifth season" by the inhabitants of the local villages. It is the time for adventurous and unique experiences like riding a boat in a forest or meadow which is flooded.
- Floods may occur in Soomaa at any time of the year or even several times a year when there is enough melt or rain water.
- At the time of the maximum flood there is an approximately 175 km² field of water, which in places is 7-8 km in width.



Kick sledding

Sometimes Soomaa meadows are flooded before winter because of rain or even in midwinter because of snow-melt. If then weather turns suddenly back to minus degrees, all flood water freezes and it is best time to go kick sledding.



Travelling in Soomaa National Park gives you an opportunity to get acquainted with the present, different people and their lifestyles.
