



Some FACTS about us

- We are a suburban area near the capital Tallinn
- East-Harju Partnership (1224,7 km²)
 covers the territory of three municipalities
 Anija, Kose and Raasiku
- The population is about **19 000** inhabitants
- The region is well-known in terms of recreational opportunities
- The activity group was created in August
 2008
- The action group has currently 55
 members (3 municipalities, 22 companies, 30 NGOs)

Positive aspects

- Good connection to Tallinn
- ☐ Stable/growing population (young families are increasing)
- □ Natural environment and recreational opportunities
- ☐ Good living environment enough space, air, forest, etc
- □ Local public services mostly available
- ☐ Mostly active communities

Problematical aspects

- □ People prefer to go to Tallinn to work, therefore they also consume many services in Tallinn
- ☐ In some places, services are not keeping up with growth (the need for kindergarten and school places etc)
- □ Business development opportunities are limited (lack of manpower and suitable premises etc)
- ☐ In some places, the communities are still inactive

Support for projects 2024-2027

LEADER total financing 1 347 029 €

- Improving the quality of the living environment 45%
- Encouraging local entrepreneurship 40%
- Building community capacity 7%
- Developing cross-regional cooperation 8%

European Social Fund financing

Strengthening social protection - 229 102 €

Maintenance costs (26% from paid projects) - 409 794 €



FOUR LEADER GOALS in the 2023-2027 strategy

- The quality of the living environment in the region has increased, as has sports, culture and leisure possibilities diversified
- 2. The region has versatile and sustainable entrepreneurship, local products and the number and volume of services has increased, and their availability has improved.
- 3. Self-initiative and capacity of the communities in the region has increased, there are more community initiatives, and the community identity has strengthened.
- 4. The region is characterized by systematic cooperation in both the business and tourism sectors as well as in the development of the living environment and communities.



For the first time we are also distributing European Social Fund Support – STRENGTHENING SOCIAL INCLUSION

- Amont of support is 1000-6029 €
- Support rate is 100%
- The target group of the measure is:
- 1) people with special needs 16+
- 2) seniors from 55+

The purpose of the measure is:

- 1) Improving the availability and quality of long-term care services and alleviating the care burden.
- 2) Ensuring human dignity and increasing social inclusion.


Just has been completed a joint marketing project for our region entrepreneurs within the both information cards and stands were made for them, as well as a joint tourism website.
